CHAIRMAN'S REPORT 2010-2011

This year has produced significant changes to our Parish in so much that, after lengthy discussions and a consultation programme with both Councillors and Residents, that after the elections in May 2011 Kingsmead will have its own Parish Council. This has been accepted by both Cheshire West and Chester Council and the Boundary Commission.

This move will, I hope, enable those elected to run the new Council and to deal with the specific issues related to Kingsmead in their own manner.

I would like to thank all those who have represented Kingsmead Ward during my term of office and wish those who will be standing for the new Council ever success in its infancy. It is hoped that even with 2 parish Councils we will still have joint meetings to discuss any matters relating to both, just as we do at present with Moulton and Bostock.

After many months of negotiations and planning the Laburnum Road field improvement project is now well advanced, with drainage, re-turfing and the laying of a perimeter path already completed. The toddler play area has also been completed.

My thanks go to all those on the committee who have organised this project for the many hours put in to see its creation. It is hope additional facilities will be forthcoming when funds are available.

Finally I would like to thank all my fellow Councillors for making my year enjoyable and last but not least our Parish Clerk for her help and assistance during the year.
